## **WHERE AND HOW TO STUDY IN CUBA.**

### **ACADEMICS**

The following modalities of study can be carried out: complete programs, partial studies, (of semesters, years or groups of subjects) distance education (open university) staying for labour practices, diploma papers and courses of levelling or of languages.

The academic year, organized by trimesters or semesters, begins the first Monday of September and concludes in the second week of July. Foreign students who register in Cuban universities must govern themselves according to educational and disciplinary regulations in force in the Cuban Higher Education.

### **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicants should be no more than 25 years old if they are to begin undergraduate studies.
- Have a high school diploma.
- In good health.
- Art, music and theatre studies required an entrance test which is taken the last week of August in Cuba.

If the applicant is accepted, should present to the Cuban authorities the following documents translated into Spanish and legalized first by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Norway and then by the Consular Section of the Cuban Embassy to Norway.

- Birth Certificate.
- Health Certificate.
- High School Graduation Diploma.
- 6 photos type 1x1.
- Certificate of proficiency in the Spanish language (if is not a Spanish speaking person).

### **INTRODUCTORY COURSES.**

The universities offer preparatory programs of levelling and of languages for students who have obtained the baccalaureate in their country and are interested in improving their preparation in Mathematics, Spanish, and other subjects. These courses also result in a propitious frame to know the Cuban university world. These courses are offered in different periods of the year, including the months of July and August.

To learn Spanish in the heart of the Caribbean where this language is spoken, using daily conversation with professors and companions is without

doubts the most effective way. Our Centres offer intensive Spanish courses, oriented by academic advisers who guide the students to choose the appropriate program.
