Journalist visas to enter Cuba must be authorized by the International Press Center of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cuba. THIS AUTHORIZATION PROCEDURE TAKES A MINIMUM OF THREE WEEKS.

Application procedure:

- Fill out this application form and send it to the Cuban Press Office of the Cuban Embassy. Attach a photocopy of the main page of your passport.
- Submit a written version of your journalistic project.
- Submit a sponsor letter from your employer.
- Submit a list of the photographic/filming equipment you intend to carry.
- You may be contacted by the Embassy's Press Secretary for clarification on your journalistic project.
- When the visa is authorized:
 - ✓ submit your passport plus 2 passport-size photographs
 - ✓ you must pay £53.00 plus application fee of £24.00 (Cash only accepted until further notice. Payment must be made directly at the consulate or through a third party. Regardless of the above, the applicant may use the postal service to send documents and must also pay a £24.00 non-personal procedure fee. Cash is not allowed to be sent by post. The embassy can't be held responsible for the loss of any document.)

Once in Cuba you must report to the **International Press Center** for accreditation. Take 2 photographs and \$1500.00 CUP.
